What is Adult Basic Education (ABE)?

Adult Basic Education includes GED programs, Basic Literacy, Family Literacy, Workplace Education, Corrections-based Education, Transitions to Higher Education, and English for Speakers of Other Languages.

Who Attends ABE?

826* residents of cities and towns in your district attend Massachusetts ABE Programs.

724 residents of cities and towns in your district are on ABE Program Waiting Lists.

In cities and towns in your district, there are 2 ABE providers operating 4 sites:

UMass Dartmouth

Service impact of Adult Basic Education funds coming into cities and towns in your district:
